What we collect

No personal information is collected. We do collect the following data:

- Pages: visited with date and time
- Workstation: type (PC/Mac), platform (Win, IOS etc.), screen size and colour depth (16/32 bit)
- Browser: type and JavaScript setting
- Demographic information: nearest town

What we do with the information we gather

We use the above information to help improve the website and to enable to cover a range of different browsers.
