Christmas Carols

Sir David Willcocks (1919-2015) is a renowned British choral conductor, organist, and composer. He is particularly known for his choral arrangements of Christmas carols.

Engelbert Humperdinck: Hansel and Gretel Overture

It is based on the Grimm brothers' fairy tale "Hansel and Gretel". The first performance on 23 December 1893 was conducted by Richard Strauss and has since been associated with Christmas.

Guiseppe Sammartini: Recorder Concerto in F

Sammartini (1695-1750) wrote a significant amount of solo sonatas. As a flute player, many of these sonatas were written for the flute, recorder, and oboe.

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart : Laudate Dominum K339

Written in 1780, this is part of a sacred choral work *Vesperae Solemnes de Confessore*. It was composed for liturgical use in the Salzburg Cathedral.

Sir Edward Elgar: Pomp and Circumstance No 4

The Pomp and Circumstance Marches (full title Pomp and Circumstance Military Marches), Op. 39, are a series of marches for orchestra composed by Sir Edward Elgar. They include some of Elgar's best-known compositions.

Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky: Extracts from The Nutcracker Suite

In 1892, Tchaikovsky made a selection of eight of the numbers from the ballet of the same name. The suite became very popular on the concert stage, and was featured in Disney's *Fantasia*.

Johann Strauss II: Thunder and Lightning Polka

One of the fastest polkas, it was performed in February 1868 in the Dianabad-Saal, with the brothers Johann, Josef and Eduard taking it in turns to conduct the Strauss Orchestra. It is played regularly at the Vienna New Year's Day Concerts.

Otto Nicolai: Christmas Overture

Nicolai (1810-1849) was a child prodigy. He was one of the founders and the first conductor of the Vienna Phil. This was written when he was 23 and based on the Bach's chorale "Von Himmel hoch, da komm ich hier."
